- * All entrants must be decorated for Christmas/Holidays
- * All entrants must have lights (preferably Christmas lights or rope lights) on their entry Strobe lights are prohibited
- * We strongly encourage building a float and/or using a flatbed trailer
- * All entrants must follow instructions and the map from the starting line until the ending location at The Pope Center on Lexington Avenue
- * No sirens, air horns or loud motorcycle mufflers are allowed due to the children and pets in the area
- * ATV entrants must be transported back to the Pope Center and cannot be ridden back. They must be with a group or organization or pulling a trailer or float
- * All signs should be neat and in bold legible letters and approved by the parade coordinators
- * All children should be escorted by a parent or adult during the parade
- * All children under the age of 17 that are on a float/trailer or in the back of a truck must be seated,
- * No candy may be thrown from floats into the crowd. A person walking along side your float will be permitted to hand out candy

The parade committee and all persons and organizations involved are not responsible for any injuries or accidents that may occur

before, during or after the event. Each participant is responsible for his or her own entry. In case of inclement weather, alternative date is scheduled for Sunday, December 8th at 6:00pm.+ judgment call will be made and relayed to local TV, radio stations and via social media 3 hours prior to parade start.
